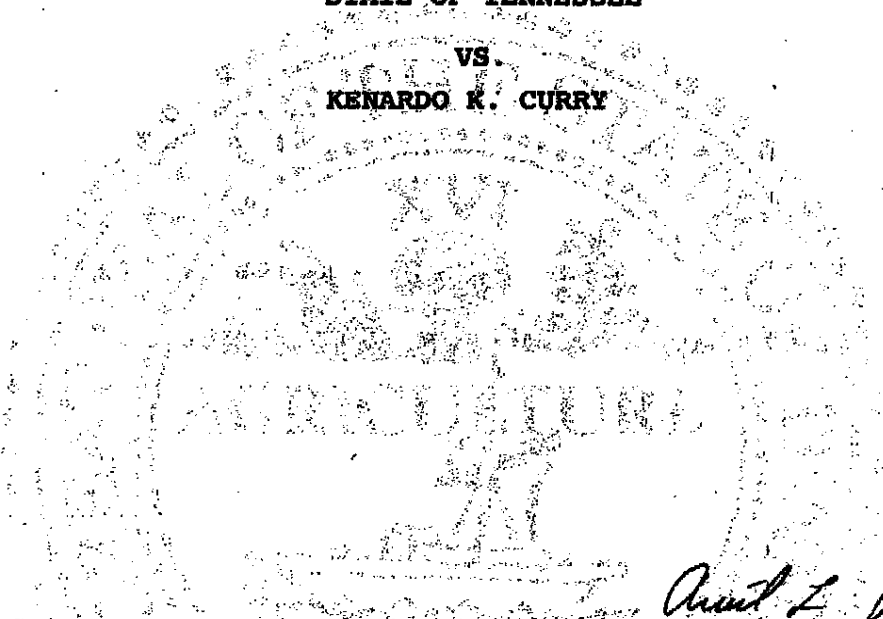

THE GRAND JURORS for the State aforesaid, being duly summoned, elected, impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire for the body of the County aforesaid, upon their oaths present:

That Kenardo K. Curry, heretofore between May 1, 2003, and February 28, 2004, in the County aforesaid, did unlawfully and knowingly obtain or exercise control of property in an amount over \$1,000.00 belonging to the City of Chattanooga, Tennessee, by the following means: the said Kenardo K. Curry, through his employment with the City of Chattanooga Neighborhood Services Department, authorized expenditures of money to the Jerry Bogo Company and to Sam's Club. Gifts of diamond earrings from Curry to two female acquaintances were purchased from the Jerry Bogo Company. A gift of a Gazelle Max exercise machine from Curry to a female acquaintance was purchased from Sam's Club. The earrings and exercise machine had nothing to do with the City of Chattanooga. All of these expenditures were paid for by the City of Chattanooga without the City's effective consent and with the intent to deprive the City of said property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated 39-14-103, against the peace and dignity of the State.
